Tribal Report

The preliminary report had been received with a number of recommendations made. A meeting between both Councils and the PCT has been held to work through the recommendations and some changes have been requested and the revised document from Tribal is awaited.

Commissioning Group Feedback

Dave Sweeney provided feedback from the recent Commissioning Group meeting. Decisions were yet to be finalised around projects that need to be mainstreamed although it was looking likely that at least two projects would be picked up by the PCT.
